ROLE OF THE INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR

INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR

Intertek was selected as the Independent Inspector to undertake the following main activities:

- Prepare a Product Compliance Report template for the submission of information, by the Signatories to demonstrate compliance with the SRI
- Independently review compliance declaration information submitted by the Signatories for completeness
- Report any issues in relation to submissions to individual Signatories in confidence, and review any subsequent resolutions
- Produce an Annual Compliance Report for the preceding Reporting Period based upon the submitted information from the Signatories
- Attend the Steering Committee meetings to present the Annual Compliance Report
- Conduct product tests to report and compare Signatory declarations against product compliance test results

INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR WORKING WITH THE SIGNATORIES

The Independent Inspector has worked independently but closely with the Signatories.

In addition to the main tasks the Independent Inspector has:

- Produced and agreed a Dispute Resolution Procedure
- Been consulted during the reviewing of the SRI in order to ensure clarity and understanding between the parties and determine the most efficient manner to report Signatory compliance

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS AND DATA COLLECTION

ANNUAL COMPLIANCE REPORT TIMELINE



SRI SPECIFIES KEY REQUIREMENTS – COVERED BY THE PCR





COMPLIANCE WITH THE SRI



Signatories must achieve the following:

- > Demonstrate that the SRI covers 80% of all the games consoles sold in the EU for the preceding Reporting Period
- > Ensure that the Product Compliance Reports for all games consoles are complete

- Ensure that Product Compliance Reports for all games consoles are submitted to the Independent Inspector on time
- Ensure that no more than 10% of products within the scope of the SRI, from an individual Signatory, fail to comply with the requirements in the SRI

ANNUAL COMPLIANCE REPORTING

The Annual Compliance Report records whether the Signatories comply with the SRI in terms of supplying information to the Independent Inspector including:

- Self declared product performance, resource efficiency and consumer information
- Market share data regarding the percentage of products within the scope of the SRI

The ACR does not report the specific product performance data against the requirements such as power caps, unless an individual product investigation has taken place during the Reporting Period

Signatories publish the Product Compliance Reports at the same time as the ACR is published

DATA COLLECTION

Template for data collection

Since the adoption of the Games Console Self Regulatory Initiative two Reporting Periods have been completed and reported upon by the Independent Inspector:

- January 2015 December 2015
- January 2016 December 2016

For each, the process of collecting and communicating product declarations has been reviewed and slightly modified

The Product Compliance Report template, based upon the SRI had some minor changes:

- To remove unnecessary data collection and reporting
- Clarity on recording the location of the resource efficiency and energy use information to consumers

SIGNATORIES



For both Reporting Periods, the Signatories were the three manufacturers that:

- ➤ Instigated and developed the Games Console SRI
- > Produce all the games console models that fall into the scope of the SRI

Microsoft Corporation

Nintendo Co. Ltd

Sony Interactive Entertainment Inc.

They represent 100% of the EU market - accounting for around 9.8 million units sold in 2016

REPORTING 2015 AND 2016 (1)



All the Signatories were compliant for the following areas:

Signatory Requirement

SRI covers 80% of the games consoles sold in the EU for the preceding period

- Signatories represent 100% of EU market

Product Compliance Reports for all games consoles submitted on time

- All reports received by 28th February

Product Compliance Reports for all games consoles are complete

- Reports for all games consoles received and completed

No more that 10% of products, within the scope of the SRI, from an individual Signatory fail to comply with the requirements in the SRI

- All, in scope, games consoles from all Signatories comply

REPORTING 2015 AND 2016 (2)



All the Signatories declared compliance for the following areas for both Reporting Periods:

- Maximum Power Consumption targets (including Tier 2 from January 2016 as appropriate)
- Auto-Power Down (APD)
- Market Coverage
- Non-energy commitments: resource efficiency and end-of-life design requirements
- Further Information: including energy and non-energy related information in the user instructions

PROGRESS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

PROGRESS MADE - DATA COLLECTION AND REVIEWS

The creation of the Product Compliance Report template in a spreadsheet allowed:

- For consistent formats across a range of consoles
- Flexibility for formatting modifications
- Submissions from one Signatory in one document
- Easy referencing across games consoles and between Signatories
- Efficient publishing format and printing

Areas addressed:

- Formatting issues, with space to put declarations regarding information to consumers
- Access to the consumer information using online links provided in the PCR
- Data transfer issues when presenting previous console information into a revised template

INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR FEEDBACK TO SIGNATORIES

Compliance communication between the Independent Inspector and Signatories

The Independent Inspector produces written individual compliance reports following submission of PCR:

- Specifies any areas requiring clarification or specifies full compliance
- Subsequent resolutions documented to individual Signatories in same manner
- Ensures fully traceable documentation of communications

COOPERATION AND REVISIONS

Following each Annual Compliance Report, recommendations provided by the Independent Inspector have been thoroughly considered

■ From format of the PCR → efficient completion of the PCR

The Independent Inspector has been consulted in relation to the SRI revisions:

- Regarding integration of EC SRI guidelines
- Time line changes
- Availability of an online PCR template
- Use of previously submitted PCR for subsequent reporting periods
