VA Administrator to prepare and distribute the minutes of the current meeting	

Summary of changes in the draft EU SRI v.5.1

Energy Efficiency (section 3.1.1 and 3.1.3)

- Alignment of Auto-Power Down (APD) requirements with objectives of Regulation (EU) 2023/826, mainly:
 - for operational modes listed in the SRI but not in scope of the regulation;
 - added consoles consuming $\leq 20\text{W}$ in Active Gaming mode as well;
 - reduced APD time from 1 hour to 20 minutes.
- Clarification of APD function implementation as per suggested by the Independent Inspector.
- Clarified scope of SRI vis-a-vis Regulation (EU) 2023/826 regarding Energy Efficiency information requirements (3.1.3).

Non-compliance (section 5.4, Annex C)

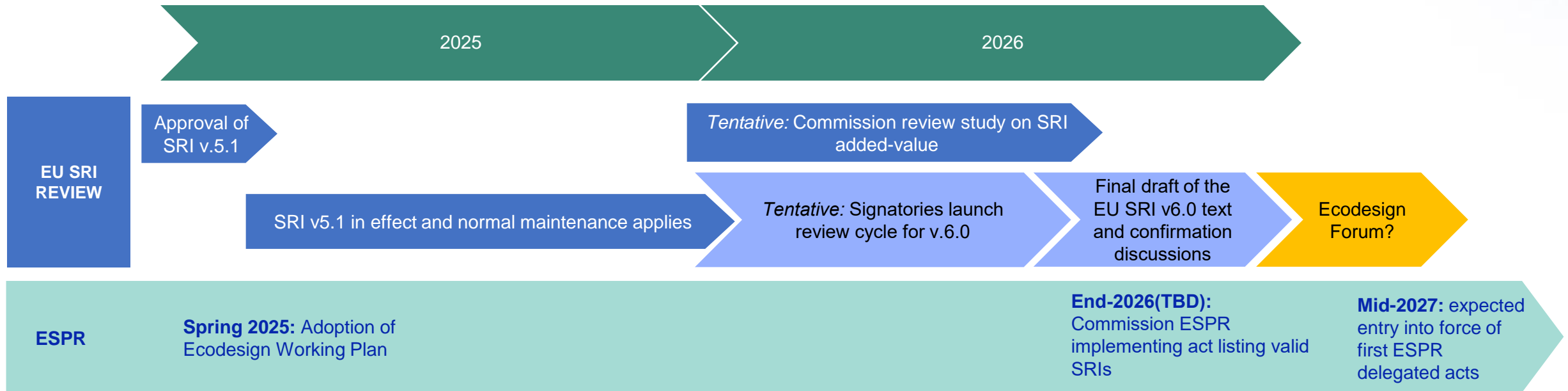
- Alignment of SRI provisions related to non-compliance with Regulation (EU) 2024/1781, whereby Signatories shall take sufficient corrective action within three months of non-compliance notification.
- Clearer timelines as to when a formal notification of non-compliance can be given, from which the three months period starts.
- Overall shorter and clearer compliance process.
- Clearer grounds for non-compliance and causes for removal of a Signatory from the SRI, in line with Regulation (EU) 2024/1781.
- Minor modifications to Annex C (Compliance investigations) to reflect changes in section 5.4.

Other changes

- Amended, where relevant, previous references to Standby Regulation (EC) No 1275/2008 and Ecodesign Directive 2009/125/EC to respectively Regulation (EU) 2023/826 and Regulation (EU) 2024/1781.
- Minor editorial polishing.
